I refer to my many correspondences to you regarding the conduct issues of Terence Goldberg.



Mr Goldberg then contrived with other persons to wind up such association and pass on the remaining monies belonging to that association to the home address of one of those persons, with that person holding criminal convictions in relation to child sex offences.

We have seen that you have quite deliberately gone to great lengths to cover up the above, despite admitting that Terence Goldberg did indeed make false statements, and later also admitting that Terence Goldberg acted for individuals rather than the association in question, which, of course, deems Mr Goldberg's actions to be improper.

What possible motive could you have for attempting to hide and cover up all the above?
