Your complaint about Kerrie-Ann Rosati

I acknowledge receipt of your letter dated 3 April 2017.

You seek to rehash criticisms of the Law Society's investigation of your complaint about Terence Goldberg which have been dealt with at length in past correspondence. No further correspondence will be entered into with respect to them. Suffice to say that I do not accept the Law Society "*went out of its way to protect Turner Freeman Lawyers*" or that there was "*evident improper handling*" of your complaint, as you assert.

Nor am I persuaded that Ms Rosati's membership of the Society and its Costs Working Group, and the fact she gives presentations and lectures for the Society, provides sufficient basis to conclude that your complaint about her will not be treated fairly and impartially by the Law Society's Professional Standards Department and Professional Conduct Committee.

Your complaint remains with Professional Standards.

This Office will not be corresponding further with you in relation to delegation of the complaint to the Law Society.
